**NOTIFICATION**

Whereas, the schedule for the General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Karnataka has been announced by the Commission vide Press Note No. ECI/PN/22/2018, dated 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2018;

2. Whereas, as per the schedule so announced by the Commission, poll for the election in the State of Karnataka is to be taken on **12.05.2018 (SAT)**; and

3. Whereas, as per the provisions of Section 126A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, there shall be restrictions on conduct of any exit poll and publication and dissemination of result of such exit poll during such period, as may be notified by the Election Commission in this regard;

4. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers under sub-Section (1) of section 126A of the R.P. Act, 1951, the Election Commission, having regard to the provisions of sub-Section (2)(b) of the said Section, hereby notifies the period between **7.00 A.M** and **6.30 P.M** on **12-05-2018 (Saturday)**, as the period during which conducting any exit poll and publishing or publicizing by means of the print or electronic media or dissemination in any other manner whatsoever, the result of any Exit Poll in connection with the current General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Karnataka announced vide the Commission's Press Note No. ECI/PN/22/2018, dated: 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2018, shall be prohibited.

5. It is further clarified that under Section 126(1)(b) of the R.P. Act, 1951, displaying any election matter including results of any opinion poll or any other poll survey, in any electronic media, would be prohibited during the period of 48 hours ending with the hour fixed for conclusion of poll in each of the phases in connection with the aforesaid General election.
